to help shore up the nation's defences against cyber
crime and gain vital experience in a commercial setting.

The programme gives university students the opportunity to work alongside senior security practitioners to deliver affordable and high-quality cyber resilience services to small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs) across England and Wales.

In the process, you would be equipped with the essential skills, knowledge and on-the-job training you need to succeed in the workplace upon graduation - whether you are looking to enter a career in the police, take up a role in the SME community or join a top-quality graduate scheme.
